Ministry Update August 13, 2012

Dear friends and partners:

I just want to give you a quick update from The Philippines. We are out of danger and the water is receding over all the flooded areas. Thank you for praying. The storm that stayed here for two weeks moved out. We have had a couple of nice days with a little rain. We just got electricity restored today at the Transformation Center. It is Monday night here. People are recovering from the floods all over this region. However, there is a new big storm that is covering the whole northern part of The Philippines. We are having some heavy rains and winds at times. The good things are the storm is moving and it is going from East to West, which is the normal way the monsoons are suppose to travel this time of year here. That is good for us because we are close to the west coast so the storms usually weaken as they come across the island and the mountains. This storm is so big it looks like it will affect us for at least two days. Which means it could cause some flooding in those places still recovering.

We traveled to our Kingdom Celebration program on Friday. The electricity came on there Friday night. At Kingdom Celebration on Saturday we were once again confronted with the increasing needs of the kids here. Several are begging us to come and live with us. Partly it is because they are in difficult situations in their homes and it is partly because of poverty. They are simply starving. One of the kids told me that the kids living with us are so lucky because they are not hungry anymore. Daily survival to get food has become their focus and that is why some of our own Kingdom Kids are traveling to the city to beg. Several are in danger of becoming street kids, which is a terrible thought for us because we know what it is like out there and the dangers they face on the streets. We can not take them all in; we need to raise more monthly support. We already feed them on Saturday's and usually Sunday's also. So we thought that maybe we can expand that and do a feeding program here for the ones in real need. We figured the best time would be at dinner so we told them they can come to our place and eat at 5 PM. They did. Tonight was the first one. We had about 25 kids that we fed tonight, see the picture below.

Goals

1. More monthly support for the ministry, to be able to continue remodeling and repairing the Transformation center Buildings; to prepare for more kids, also to be able to do more outreaches, and expand the Internet ministry.
2. \$23,000 US dollars for a Toyota 15 Passenger van, our current van is a 1994 Toyota that is not usable at this time. We are currently without our own transportation.
3. \$35,000 USD to purchase the farm lot behind the Transformation Center to grow fruits and vegetables for the ministry and for possible income.
4. Funds for remodeling the Transformation Center we possibly need \$50,000 USD for completion but we can work in stages as funds become available. We need \$10,000 to make the buildings able to handle the monsoon rains and prevent more damage.

We are so thankful for the Lord's provision and we are so thankful for YOU. All of you who have prayed for us and given financially to help us get this far, THANK YOU! We know that the Lord sends very special people to help in this ministry. The Lord is the one building the Transformation Center; He is the One producing fruit in the lives of people as each of us cooperate with Him.
